### Price system

#### Basic charges

Charges vary  
depending on  
the price plan.

#### Additional charges

Additional charges will be applied for each single use of a bicycle whenever  
the usage time exceeds 60 minutes under any of the plans.

- An additional charge of 100 yen per 30 minutes will be applied if the usage time exceeds 60 minutes.
- These additional charges are capped at 1,000 yen if the bicycle is returned within 24 hours after use.
- An additional charge of 1,000 yen per day will be applied if the usage time exceeds 24 hours.

### One-month use, Six-months use, One-year use - For commuters -

**A period starts from the date of registration.**

Example: Register on April 20 → Usage period: April 20 to May 19 (for one-month use)

If you register using a credit card through our website, your membership will be automatically renewed on the day after the expiry date, and your credit card will be automatically charged.

### One-time use - For people who just want a quick bicycle ride -

**There are no additional charges if your usage time is 60 minutes or less.**

Example:

Usage time: 45 minutes → Usage charge 100 yen (= basic charge (100 yen) + additional charge (0 yen))

Usage time: 2 hr. 20 minutes → Usage charge 400 yen (= basic charge (100 yen) + additional charge (300 yen))

### Repeated 60-minute use - For people who want to go sightseeing, taking several rides per day -

**This plan is recommended if you want to ride three or more times per day.**

There are no additional charges if your usage time is 60 minutes or less.

\* Please note that all rides should be completed within a 24-hour period.

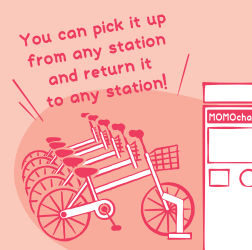
## MOMOchari Q&A

### Can I pick up and return a bicycle anywhere I like?

You can return your bicycle to any bicycle station no matter where you picked it up.

### Can I keep a bicycle for a month if I have a pass?

Although there is no maximum bicycle rental time limit, an additional charge of 100 yen per 30 minutes will be applied if the usage time exceeds 60 minutes (up to a daily limit 1,000 yen). Moreover, an additional charge of 1,000 yen per day will be applied if the usage time exceeds 24 hours.



### What can I do if I cannot return my bicycle because a bicycle rack is full?

Please lock your bicycle, and put its key in a key box located next to the pay station. Then proceed with the return procedure by pressing the "Bicycle return when bicycle racks are full" button\* on the pay station.

\* Please note that an additional charge will be applied unless you complete the return procedure.

### Can I use a bicycle even if I do not have ICOCA or Hareca?

You can rent a bicycle by purchasing a dedicated MOMOchari membership card (500 yen). MOMOchari cards are available from the Management Office and some municipal parking lots.

\* The 500 yen is a deposit. This will be returned to you when you cancel your membership.

### What is the minimum age for using a bicycle?

There are no age restrictions. However, we recommend that bicycle riders be 138 cm or taller. We also ask that children younger than 13 years of age to wear a helmet.

## Smartphone app

The MOMOchari app allows you to check how many bicycles there are at each bicycle station in real-time.



### Functions

**[MAP]** The map displays bicycle station information (such as their location, the number of available bicycles, and the number of available rack spaces for bicycle return). Linked with GPS, the app can show you the distance between your current location and the nearest bicycle station.

**[Member's page]** This page allows users to check their usage plan, usage history, and purchase history, as well as to register, check, and edit their membership information.

## How to Use MOMOchari

**What you need when you register at a roadside station:** A Felica-compatible IC card\*<sup>1</sup> such as ICOCA, Hareca, or Osaifu-Keitai (mobile wallet) + a mobile phone or Smartphone capable of receiving text messages

**What you need when you register at the Management Office:** A Felica-compatible IC card\*<sup>1</sup> such as ICOCA, Hareca, or Osaifu-Keitai (mobile wallet) + ID (e.g. a driver's license, health insurance card, passport, resident card, or student card)

\* Dedicated MOMOchari cards are available at our Management Office if you do not have a compatible card (deposit: 500 yen).

## Renting a bicycle

\* You only need to go through steps 1 through 3 on your first time.

### STEP 1

Press [Register] > [New Registration] at a roadside terminal, and enter your name and mobile phone number, then select a plan.

### STEP 2

You will receive a text message containing your ID and password.

### STEP 3

Press [Confirm Registration] and enter your ID and password.

### STEP 4

Hold your card over the roadside terminal and select [Payment Method].

### STEP 5

Pay the basic charge.

### STEP 6

When you hold your card over the card reader on the left side of a bicycle rack, the LED lamp changes from "blinking" to "off."

### STEP 7

Pull out a bicycle from the rack.



Start using the bicycle!

Renting a bicycle is very easy, isn't it?

## Returning a bicycle

### STEP 1

Return your bicycle to a bicycle rack. Check that the card reader lamp changes from "off" to "on."

### STEP 2

- A. If you are returning your bicycle within 60 minutes, you only need to return the bicycle to the rack.
- B. If you are returning your bicycle after 60 minutes or more have passed, hold your card over the roadside terminal and select the method of payment for the additional charge.



### STEP 3

Press [Pay Additional Charges], pay the charges, and press [Complete] when the additional charge display window reads [None].

Your bicycle has been returned!

Returning the bicycle is also very easy, isn't it?



## Methods of payment for additional charges

We accept a wide range of payment methods including cash, credit cards, transit IC cards (ICOCA, etc.). \* Payment via Hareca is not available.
